

Eagles suffer bad weekend in Boone

BOONE - The Kirkwood baseball team spent a weekend in Boone they would like to quickly forget. The 19th-ranked Eagles were swept by DMACC in a league doubleheader for the second straight on Sunday, 12-4 and 9-6. Kirkwood was outscored, 42-13, in the four-game series, dropping its records to 10-6 overall and 0-4 in the conference.

Will Ross was the starting pitcher for Kirkwood in the first game Sunday. He was touched for 13 hits and nine earned runs in six innings.

Zach Patterson, Eric Schenck-Joblinske, Angel Merced and Austin Schmitt had two hits apiece for the Eagles in the second game Sunday as their bats

began to come alive. Matt Paciello drove in two runs.

Jeffrey Castillo began the nightcap on the mound for Kirkwood, but he faced only seven batters and was roughed up for six runs in only one-third of an inning.
