Northeast scored three times in the bottom of third inning for a 3-1 lead. Kirkwood pulled within 3-2 in the top of the fourth and grabbed a 5-3 advantage in the fifth with three more runs, knocking Northeast ace Cam Taylor (7-2) out of the game.

Southeastern (39-17) will face Iowa Central (33-18) in the other winner's bracket semifinal Friday in the double-elimination tournament.

Northeast won the season series, 3-1, against Kirkwood this year.
